- 5. Discuss and analyse the complexities involved in the operation of a faith-based school within a secular social context.

- 3. The development of Christian Parent-Controlled (CEN) schools
- 4. Other models of distinctively Christian schooling in Australia and internationally
- 5. The vision and mission of Christian schools: Research into alternative conceptions of Christian schooling
